About Migrafrica:

The core concept of the organisation is to increase the role of former refugees and migration organizations in the integration of newly arriving, resettled or relocated refugees to welcoming host communities.

*Main target group are young people.

Direct support to newly arriving, resettled or relocated refugees:

Main challenges:

- ↗ Building trust and psychological support
- ↗ Information gap and cultural differences
- ↗ Decent housing and healthcare services
- ↗ Economic participation
- ↗ Social and political participation

Support to new arriving, resettled or relocated refugees:

- ↗ Migrant's platform that engages former refugees to assist newly arriving migrants
(providing advice, accompanying and translation)
- ↗ Orientation and integration
(Asylum process, training and education, job market integration and entrepreneurship)
- ↗ Connecting newly arriving refugees, institutions and their host communities
(translation, orientation, motivation and social capital)

Support to migrant organizations:

The need for RSYPA project:

- ↗ High barriers to social and political participation of young migrants
- ↗ High unemployment and barriers to access higher education and trainings
- ↗ Barriers to access decent housing and health care

The objectives of RSYPA project:

- ↗ To facilitate dialogue between young migrants and decision makers at various levels
- ↗ Promote network between migrant youth organizations and build their capacity
- ↗ Promote entrepreneurship among young migrants

Methodology:

- ↗ Phase 1: Initiation and preparation
- ↗ Phase 2: Consolidation phase
- ↗ Phase 3: Moderation phase
- ↗ Phase 4: Evaluation and follow up

Outcome & Sustainability:

- ↗ Development of a methodology for facilitating migrant youth political participation
- ↗ Increased participation of migrant organizations for migrant youth social participation
- ↗ More resources are available because of the increased network and collaboration with other stakeholders
- ↗ Increased visibility of the role of migrant organizations for social inclusion and participation
- ↗ Follow up projects

Recommendations:

- ↗ Migrant youth social and political participation requires a comprehensive approach in which trust building activities play a central role.
- ↗ Migrant youth economic participation and job market integration facilitates social and political participation
- ↗ Further engagement of Migrants in the work of integrating newly arriving refugees to welcoming communities
- ↗ Accessibility of funds and resources
